- Improve student's numeracy abilities as per our School's improvement agenda.
- Ensure that 100% of students achieve greater than National Minimum Standard on 2020 Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN Numeracy test.
- Ensure that 100% of students are achieving at or above a C standard on Semester 1 and 2 reports for Mathematics.

Our initiatives include

- Whole School Numeracy Program from Prep to year 6.
- Regular assessment and conferencing with students to improve numeracy goals.
- Learning and Development for staff around teaching numeracy, including open-ended questioning skills, unpacking units of work to develop explicit student knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum standards.
- Participate in moderation with northern North Burnett cluster of schools – once per term to inform teaching practices.
- Participate in northern North Burnett cluster of schools – numeracy improvement agenda.
- Each school newsletter will have a numeracy page dedicated to informing parents of effective strategies for students, as well as a positive focus on the importance of numeracy skills using research-based evidence.
